Dear Parents,

If your child wants to go to Germany next year you might find the following information helpful.

Just about one month ago we hosted 15 students and 3 teachers from the Franziskus Gymnasium in Mutlangen near Stuttgart, Germany. Feedback from our host families and our guests about this first phase of the exchange was highly successful. The Record Journal ran a very positive story about the benefits of the exchange.

Moran's Mr. Andreson summed up the experience at Moran Middle School as "electrifying".

Our guests returned to Germany and it is now time begin the early planning phase for the return visit.

We are planning to have next year's visit towards the end of June 2016, approximately a week after our last day of school, depending on the number of snow days. Note that Franziskus Gymnasium's school year goes to the end of July.

These are the parameters to consider for an application:

- The students who hosted and want to travel next year will get first consideration.
 - We anticipate that an additional 5 10 students will be able to travel, aside from those who hosted.
 - We are seeking applicants at both Sheehan High School and Moran Middle School.
 - Preference will be given to those students who are enrolled in the German program at Sheehan.
 - 8th grade students at Moran can still sign up for German in their freshman year in high school, but will have to do so through the Sheehan guidance department.
 - Early decisions will be given preference. Ideally by the end of this school year!

This will be an incredible opportunity for our students to travel to one of Germany's most successful states, the home of Porsche, Mercedes Benz, Bosch and many more globally successful businesses.

They will travel for approximately 2 weeks, attend school with their German host students and be welcome by their guest families. German hospitality is world renown and the regions is known for great cuisine.

This exchange will allow our students to get to know Germany and German culture through personal connections and finding new friends. We anticipate the cost to be approximately \$ 1,500. Additional fundraising could lower the cost!
